

## Eastener


- Everything is a picture

## The Land of Milk

Milk -> this would be from Goats -> Where shepherds bring their flocks to graze -> the Desert (barren & desolate)

- Product of the Shepherd

Milk is a Type for Nourishment & Provision



# The Land Of Honey

Honey -> Israel's Farmland -> fertile and productive

- Product of the farmer
- 2 types
  - Bee honey
  - Jam figs & dates most references in Bible

## See the Picture

The land of Israel is a land that can support both Milk (Shepherd's herds) and Honey (Farmland) - very rare

### Isaiah 7:

In that day the Lord will whistle for flies from the Nile delta in Egypt and for bees from the land of Assyria. 19 They will all come and settle in the steep ravines and in the crevices in the rocks, on all the thorn bushes and at all the water holes. 20 In that day the Lord will use a razor hired from beyond the Euphrates River—the king of Assyria—to shave your head, and to cut off your beard also. 21 In that day, a person will keep alive a young cow and two goats. 22 And because of the abundance of the milk they give, there will be curds to eat. All who remain in the land will eat curds and honey.
